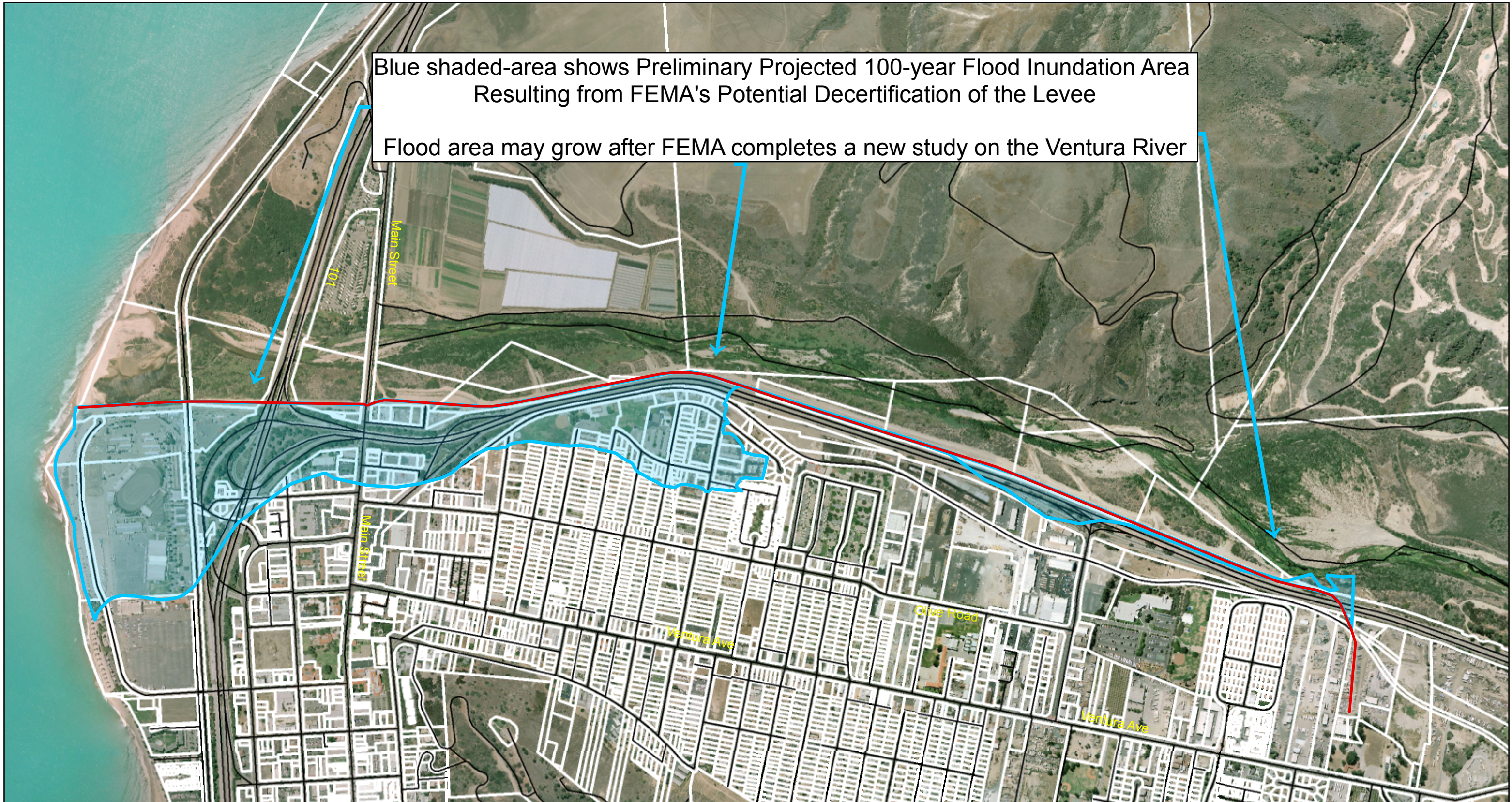






Blue shaded-area shows Preliminary Projected 100-year Flood Inundation Area Resulting from FEMA's Potential Decertification of the Levee
