
- Highlights in 2025
- Definitions <u>12100</u>
 - Are you an applicant or permittee? Before and after permit issued.
 - Are you constructing an encroachment or doing encroachment work?
- Permit Required <u>12200</u>
 - Do you need a permit? Yes. Any permanent construction, any activity.
- Road Closures <u>12206</u>
 - Can you just close the road? No. Must plan ahead. Closure cannot interfere with safe and convenient travel of general public.
 - Soft versus hard closures.
- Abandonments <u>12209</u>

 - Can you abandon pipes in the road right-of-way? No. Abandoned or outof-service pipes are still encroachments. Must received permission to abandon.



• When is Permit Required?

- When is a permit required (<u>12200</u>)? Most activities in road R/W.
 16 listed.
 - 12200 Permit required.
 - (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Division, it is unlawful for any person to do any of the following without first obtaining a permit from the Commissioner:
 - (1) Make or cause to be made any encroachment, including any excavation, in any highway;
 - (2) Place, change, or renew an existing encroachment in any highway;
 - (3) Place, construct, or repair any curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway approach, pavement, base course, retaining wall, storm drain, culvert, pipe, conduit, cable, or other work of similar nature in, over, along, across, or through any highway;

Permit Required ~ When?

Consequences of Working without Permit

- What are the consequences of working without a permit?
 - Misdemeanor and Liable ~ <u>12200(b)</u> ~ Any person who does any of the acts specified in this Section, without first having obtained a permit, is guilty of a misdemeanor and is liable to the County for all expenses and damages caused by the act.
 - Double Fees ~ <u>12605(b)</u> ~ Where any person, without having first obtained a permit, does any act for which this Division requires a permit, the specified permit fees are doubled. Payment of such double fee does not relieve any person from any requirement of this Division or from any penalty prescribed by this Division.

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Permit Required ~ Standard Conditions

- Standard Conditions ~ Highlights
- Emergency & local access.
- Flaggers (per CA MUTCD) ~ can see each other & radio communication.
- Road closures ~ plan ahead, monitors.
- Working near schools ~ congestion around schools.
- Peak hours ~ roads with restricted hours (7-9 a.m., 4-6 p.m.).
- Slurry backfill ~ required/preference.
- Restoration of road right-of-way (extend three (3) times then RT may restore roadway and invoice permittee).
- Links ~ everything needed for permit.



2023 ENCROACHMENT PERMIT STANDARD CONDITIONS

Submittal. By submitting a signed permit application, Permittee accepts and agrees to comply with all terms and conditions, including those appearing on the permit application, these standard conditions, and all special conditions.

Conditions. Permittee is responsible for compliance with all conditions of the permit, regardless of whether Permittee employs contractors or others to perform the work.

WORKING WITHOUT A PERMIT:

Volation. Any person who performs work or construits activities in the right-of-way of a county-maintained rodwy that work requires a permit signify of a midmemant and is lable to the county for all expenses and any damages caused by the work or activity. VCPWA-RT may issue any permit on behalf of the person performing the work or conducting the activity without pre-expiration and the Permittee will be subject to all fees and costs required by the permit and the most current fee schedule (Fees). Any work without a permit is subject to panify fees. For more information, see EC 0440 (Co.4550).

WORKING WITH AN EXPIRED PERMIT:

Extensions. Any valid permit that has expired with work not completed will be automatically extended nihely (80) days by the County's permitting software and charged a permit extension fee. If requested in writing prior to the permit expland date, ene extension of a reasonable duration will be granted at no charge. - Can Excavator close a highway (<u>12206</u>)? No. Soft closures. <u>Bonus.</u>
 - 12206 Road closure, interference with highway use.

A permittee must plan and execute an encroachment in such a manner that the encroachment will not **unreasonably interfere** with the safe and convenient travel of the general public. Unless authorized in the permit, no permittee may **close** a public highway or **deny** to the general public the use of the public highway....





Encroachment Permits are required for any work proposed within the County's road right-of-way and includes such work as utility installations and repairs, roadway and drainage improvements by developers, driveway construction, sidewalk repair, filming of motion pictures and still photography, placement of obstructions in the right-of-way such as fences, trees, poles, and overhead structures. Roadside vendors are not permitted in the road right-of-way. The Permits Section ensures that all construction work in the public right-of-way complies with County's adopted codes and engineering standards. In addition, the Section issues Transportation Permits for oversize vehicles travelling on County roads and collects Traffic Impact Mitigation fees. In 2020, a new Kdopt-a-Road Program road roadside litter cleanup was implemented.


















