**Notice of Availability of a Draft Environmental Impact Report  
Hueneme Road Widening Project**

The County of Ventura (County) Department of Public Works proposes to widen Hueneme Road to include four vehicle lanes, a paved median, buffered bike lanes, and paved shoulders (project). The project is located on Hueneme Road between Edison Drive to the east and Rice Avenue to the west. The purpose of the project is to improve vehicle and bicycle travel and safety, improve the freight movement corridor, increase connectivity for bicycle riders, and complete vehicle and bicycle improvements consistent with the General Plan. The project has been included in regional transportation plans and studies.
